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

### Open Science: Making Scientific Research Accessible

Open science is a movement aimed at making scientific research, data, and dissemination accessible to all levels of an inquiring society, amateur or professional. It encompasses practices such as publishing open research, campaigning for open access, encouraging scientists to practice open-notebook science, and generally making it easier to publish and communicate scientific knowledge. The goals of open science include enhancing the transparency, reproducibility, and collaboration in research, thereby accelerating scientific discovery and innovation.

### Key components of open science include:

- 1. **Open Access:** This refers to the practice of providing unrestricted access via the Internet to peer-reviewed scholarly research. Open access can be either gratis (free of charge) or free of charge and with additional usage rights.
- 2. **Open Data:** This involves making the data underlying scientific research available to everyone. Open data allows for the verification of results and enables other researchers to use the data for new studies, which can lead to further discoveries.
- 3. **Open Methodology:** Sharing the methods and protocols used in research allows others to replicate studies and verify results, which is crucial for the integrity of scientific research.
- 4. **Open Source:** In the context of software, open source means that the source code is made available to the public, allowing anyone to view, modify, and distribute the code. This is particularly important in computational research.
- 5. **Open Peer Review:** This is a process where the identities of both the authors and reviewers are known to each other, and the review reports are published alongside the article. This can increase the transparency and accountability of the peer review process.
- 6. **Open Educational Resources:** These are teaching, learning, and research resources that are free of cost and access barriers, and which also carry legal permission for open use.
- 7. **Citizen Science:** This involves public participation and collaboration in scientific research with the aim to increase scientific knowledge. Through citizen science, people share and contribute to data monitoring and collection programs.

### Face-to-Face

BigInfo spoke this month to Dr. Lata Suresh. Head of the Knowledge Resource Centre, Indian Institute of corporate Affairs, GOI, eminent artist, author, trainer and social influencer. Some excerpts:



#### BI: Please describe your professional journey and important landmarks.

LS: My professional journey has been an enriching experience, spanning over three decades across academia, corporate governance, literature, and social service. Some key milestones include: Earning my PhD from the University of Pune, along with multiple master's degrees in Information Science, HR & Drivation, and Sociology, Advance diploma in IT and e-commerce, PG D in Cyber Law. Apart from various other fields, which laid the foundation for my multidisciplinary expertise; serving as the Head of the Knowledge Resource Centre, Institutional Partnerships, and Corporate. Communications at the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Govt. of India); being awarded the Commonwealth Professional Fellowship by the British Council; authoring 14 books and publishing over 60 plus articles in national and international journals, serving as a certified trainer(certified by NHRD) in leadership, soft skills, and POSH (Prevention of Sexual Harassment); receiving over 30 prestigious awards, including the APJ Kalam National Award, Nari Shakti Award, Best Librarian awards from various Organisations and Professional Bodies, and international accolades like the National Excellence Award in Istanbul, Turkey, SLA Asian ProfessionalAward at Chicago, USA. Each of these milestones has shaped my professional identity and reinforced my commitment to lifelong learning, innovation, and social impact.

#### BI: Please describe the challenges of a corporate librarian and how you manage these.

**LS:** The role of a corporate librarian extends beyond traditional library management to encompass knowledge curation, technology integration, and strategic communication. With the shift towards digital resources, corporate libraries must continuously adapt to new technologies, maintain access to reliable databases, and ensure cybersecurity in knowledge management. I address this by incorporating Al-driven cataloging, digital repositories, and automation for efficient knowledge dissemination along with introducing new features in the department and employing knowledge mapping, Al-driven analytics, and content curation strategies to streamline information access. Securing funding for digital resources, research tools, and training programs is a recurring challenge.

I manage this by advocating for CSR-funded library projects, institutional collaborations, and cost-effective open-access solutions. While digital access is crucial, physical libraries still hold value for in-depth research. I ensure a hybrid model that integrates both digital and print collections effectively. I had always believed in Quality collection instead of a dumping station. Through strategic planning, technology adoption, and user-centric services, I have been able to transform the corporate library landscape into a dynamic knowledge hub.

# BI. As a Librarian, Author, Speaker, Social Influencer, and Professional Singer, how do you manage to multitask your life so successfully?

**LS:** Balancing multiple roles requires a blend of time management, passion, and strategic planning. Here's how I approach it: I follow a structured routine where I allocate dedicated time for research, writing, public speaking, and music. Leveraging goal-setting techniques and productivity tools helps me stay focused.

My roles complement each other—my work as a librarian/Head of the Department and author enhances my speaking engagements, while my leadership training fuels my ability to guide professionals. This interconnectedness reduces redundancy and maximizes efficiency. Continuous learning allows me to keep evolving across disciplines. Whether it's leadership, NLP, or digital transformation, I ensure that I stay updated with emerging trends.

# BI. Please share your views on the emerging information landscape and challenges before libraries.

LS:The information landscape is rapidly evolving with advancements in AI, big data, and digital transformation, presenting both opportunities and challenges for libraries. Libraries must integrate AI-powered chatbots, data analytics, and automated indexing to enhance accessibility and efficiency. The demand for open-access resources is growing. Libraries need to expand their digital repositories, promote research visibility, and ensure equitable access to knowledge. The rise of fake news and misinformation necessitates stronger media literacy programs and fact-checking mechanisms within libraries.

With increasing digitization, protecting user data and ensuring secure access to resources is a significant challenge, The evolving landscape demands continuous upskilling in data science, digital curation, and knowledge management to stay relevant in the profession.

Libraries must redefine their role from information providers to knowledge facilitators, digital curators, and learning enablers to thrive in this dynamic era.





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
