

A Beautiful Life Cut-Short




Receiving the Golden Award on Completing 50 Years in Publishing Industry on September 28th, 2024

Library Associations Across the Country Mourn the Death of Mr. Kailash Balani, Publisher, Friend and a Philosopher

Shaken by his sudden demise, the Help-Library Mission, a charitable trust founded by Mr. Kailash Balani during the COVID-19 breakout to help the needy Library professionals, Management Libraries Network, New Delhi and Asian Library Association, New Delhi, India organised an online condolence meeting on 3rd November 2024 in the loving memory of Mr. Kailash Balani.

The meeting was attended by a large number of members of these associations who expressed their deep shock and sorrow in the sudden death of Mr. Balani. The participants shared their fond memories of Mr. Balani and how he played a pioneering role in providing services and resources to libraries in India and neighboring countries. He was a well-meaning and genuine entrepreneur who introduced a large number of products in Indian Market during the last 50 years of his illustrious publishing career. It was emphasised that he was ahead of his times in his thinking and was among very few globally to transform from print to electronic publishing at a very early stage. Mr. Balani was the one who introduced the concept of the consortium model of acquisition and laid the foundation of INDEST consortium which later merged with UGC- INFONET.





During the last decade, Balani Infotech, the flagship company of Balani Group introduced several web-based tools like turnitin, DrillBit, Lanquill, and Sciflow to leverage emerging technologies. Despite his strong business sense, Mr. Balani always emphasised on conducting business ethically and generously. He spent a huge amount on philanthropic activities. The meeting was attended, among others, by Prof. Roshan Raina, Mr. Sujan Sekhar Mr. N.V. Sathyanarayana of Informatics, Mr.M. Chettiar of Bharat Book Bureau, Prof.PV Kannur, Dr. MG.
