Emerging Trends & Technologies:

Measuring Research Impact : The Emerging Metrics

h-index

- It was created by Jorge E. Hirsch, a physicist.
- The h-index is relatively young and dates back to 2005.
- It doesn't account for the quality of journals and self-citations.
- It varies across different databases (Scopus, WOS, Google Scholar).
- The h-index isn't just for individuals but also groups, research labs, and journals.

i10-index

- Specific to Google Scholar.
- Counts the number of publications with at least 10 citations.
- It's simple and shows you the number of highly cited papers at a glance.

g-index

- Created by Leo Egghe in 2006.
- g is the largest number of articles cited at least g^2 times.
- Gives more weight to highly cited articles than the h-index.

m-index

- Accounts for the length of a researcher's career.
- Divides the h-index by the years since author's 1st publication.
- Can be useful for comparing researchers at different career stages.

p-index

- Proposed as a fairer alternative to the h-index.
- Each citing author is only counted once for a given publication.
- Solves the issue of excessive self-citation or colleagues' citations.

C-Score

- Excludes self-citations.
- Takes into account first, single, and last authorship.
- Normalizes citations per number of authors in each paper.

Clarivate Journal Citation Report 2024

The 2024 update of Clarivate Journal Citation Report provides a comprehensive resource of high-quality journals, ranked by field to enable academic institutions, researchers, and publishers to gauge the significance of journals in the global research landscape. Changes to journal rankings include the addition of the Emerging Sources Citation Index. Only the journals that have met the rigorous quality standards for inclusion in the Web of Science Core Collection are featured within the Journal Citation Reports. This ensures that researchers can confidently rely on the information and descriptive data provided. It consists of a rich array of publisher-independent data, metrics, and analysis to enhance user understanding of journal performance, including the widely recognised Journal Impact Factor (JIF) and the Journal Citation Indicator (JCI).

For the first time, the JCR includes unified rankings across subject categories. There will no longer be separate JIF rankings for the nine subject categories that are indexed in multiple editions. Now those journals will receive a single ranking in their subject category, and the separate rankings will be eliminated. For example, a psychiatry journal listed in SCIE and SSCI will now be ranked in one unified Psychiatry ranking rather than two.

IIT Jodhpur Implements Real-Time Research Data Visualisation Dashboard

In a significant development, IIT Jodhpur Library has recently implemented the Real-Time Research Data Visualisation Dashboard, which allows the user community to know the complete research pattern of the Institute. The dashboard analyses the complete research output and allows the users to know the publication pattern by source type, keywords, citation, subject, and collaboration by way of visually rich graphical charts. This tool pulls data of publications from OpenAlex (openalex.org), an open bibliographic catalogue of scientific papers, authors, and institutions, and feeds into the dashboard to generate different analytics.

This tool has been developed by Dr. Vinod Kumar Mishra, Assistant Librarian, NIT Rourkela, and Team IITJ Library has installed and customized it. According to Dr. Kshema Prakash, Deputy Librarian, IITJ, they are working together with Dr. Mishra, for adding more features into this dashboard.

The Manas, with the inimitable stamp of Tulsi's loftiness of mind and poetic genius, is nevertheless an epic consisting of 12,800 lines divided into 1,073 stanzas and seven kands or sections. These nominations highlight the cultural and historical significance of India's vast documentary heritage and underscores the importance of preserving our rich culture.

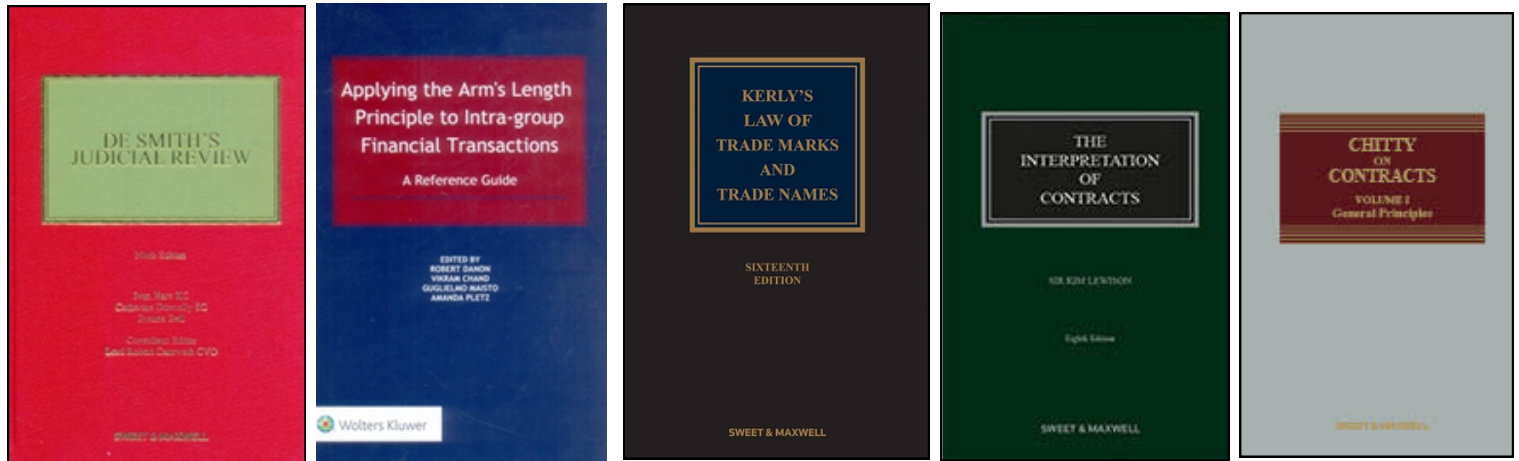
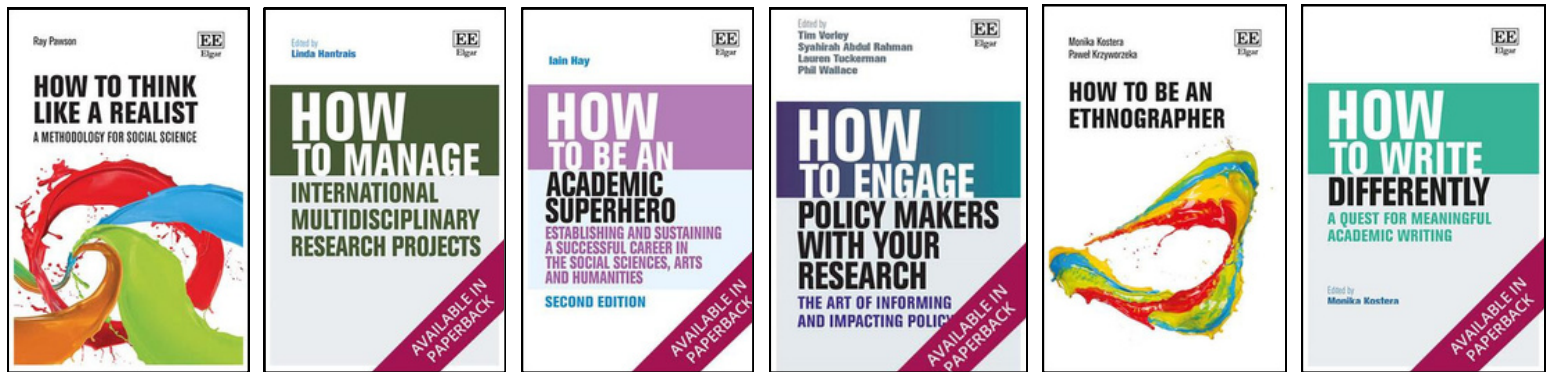

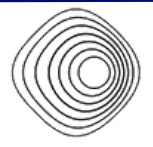
